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RiverView Cottages

Our 6 cottages sleep from 2-12 people and have fully equipped kitchen, living room area, bathroom and satellite TV. We also have canoes and kayaks available for our customers. You have access to the Moose River from our dock area, which you can paddle to nearby Big Wood Lake and Long Pond, or just kick back and enjoy the scenery at the cottages. We've been known to see moose and deer on the field in front of the cottages. There is a volleyball net and horseshoe pits on the property. Charcoal grills available. Pets are welcome.

Hunting and Fishing

Hunt moose, deer, bear, or snowshoe hares. Jackman is known for the abundant wildlife and trophy-sized moose and the '200 Plus Buck Club'. You can be fully guided or hunt on your own. Either way you'll come back to a warm and comfortable cottage. Fish the Jackman/Moose River area on one of the countless brooks and streams, or on one of the many lakes and ponds in the nearby area. You'll be sure to enjoy the surroundings, and don't forget to bring your net!

Snowmobiling and A.T.V.ing

Groomed snowmobile trails from your cottage door will connect you via ITS 89 to Canada, Rockwood, Greenville, Eustis and beyond. Our ATV trails are excellent also, with some of the most beautiful scenery and remote areas that you would not be able to see otherwise. These trails are also directly accessed from your cottage. Always remember to ride safe and bring a camera!

Wilderness Adventures

Hike, bike, snowshoe or paddle a canoe. There are trails for all kinds of outdoor enthusiasts. There is also whitewater rafting available in the area. Jackman is one of the most beautiful parts of the state. Come see why we call Jackman "The Switzerland of Maine".

Directions:

Take Rte. 201 North to Jackman. After the bridge over the Moose River turn at the Border Trust Bank. Then take the next right onto River Road. It's about a mile to RiverView Cottages, which are at the end of River Road, and located along the Moose River.
